Together For Humanity is an inclusive educational organisation that works with schools to foster intercultural understanding and help students learn how to deal with differences. They stand for acceptance of every person regardless of race, ethnicity or faith.

The Covid-19 restrictions in Sydney in May 2020 meant that the annual lunch at Parliament House could not go ahead.

Catalyst Management was engaged to help pivot their traditional event into an online activation. The strategy involved a professionally produced 1-hour live panel discussion and audience Q&A hosted by Geraldine Doogue AO, with high profile panellists Norman Swan, Father Frank Brennan, Alpha Cheng and Calisha Bennett, and featuring TFH National Director Rabbi Zalman Kastel AM, using our content production partner Barking Mouse, who streamed the event live from Governor Phillip Tower.
